

Pharmacy Technician Training



The **non-credit** Pharmacy Technician program at Lawson State Community College will prepare students to take the Pharmacy Technician Certification exam (PTCE) for the State of Alabama. After completing this training, you will have a Pharmacy Technician License (ALBOP), which will allow you to start working in a Pharmacy as a Pharmacy Technician.



Program Length: 16-Weeks ~ Program Cost: \$2,000.00

Program Components

Ready to Work - Employability Skills	4- Weeks	Completers of this 4-week required component will receive a \$300.00 Stipend
Pharmacy Tech Concentration	8-Weeks	Completers of these two components will receive a \$350.00 stipend
Clinical at Walgreens or CVS	4-Weeks	

You will receive \$650.00 for completing the entire program as long as grant funds are available.

Program Requirements:

- High School Diploma/GED
- Pass Drug Test
- Pass Background Check

DHR Referrals:

There is no charge for this training if you receive any services from DHR (food stamps, daycare, etc.)

Non-DHR Referrals – WIOA Option:

Students who do not receive services through DHR may qualify for WIOA funding. WIOA will pay for course fees, background check, drug testing, Pharmacy Technician Registration, books, and uniforms. **For instructions on how to apply for WIOA, Contact Tomeka Minnifield as soon as possible at 205-929-6384, tminnifield@lawsonstate.edu.** You need to get approved for WIOA funding before the class starts.

Payment Plan:

Students who do not receive services through DHR, and do not qualify for WIOA may pay out-of-pocket utilizing the payment plan schedule below:
