**A**n individual must have at least a 3.0 grade point average to qualify for membership. In exchange for a tuition only scholarship, each Ambassador agrees to perform a minimum of 50 clock hours of service to the college each semester. Service includes, but is not limited to events such as college open houses, high school senior tours, civic and social events, recruiting, meetings, high school career/college day activities and other meetings and affairs of the college. All members of the Lawson State Ambassadors' team must maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.0 during the entire term of membership.
